Ceremony/Reception

In order to host a ceremony at the Knoxville Convention Center, we require that you also hold a reception (food function) at the Center.

Parking

Parking is available at various locations around the Center at an additional price.

Rehearsal

One hour is allotted for ceremony rehearsal to be held one day prior to ceremony. Specific space for rehearsal is not guaranteed. We do not guarantee that you will have ample space for your requirements.

Rice, Birdseed, Glitter

Can not be thrown inside or outside the Center for safety and cleaning reasons.

Smoking Policy

The Knoxville Convention Center is a non-smoking facility. Designated areas have been provided for smoking guests outside the Center.

Open Flames

Open flames are not permitted in the Knoxville Convention Center. Candles must be enclosed in a Hurricane Globe or Votive Holder. **Candelabras are not allowed.**

Entertainment

Bands or DJ's with electrical requirements will be subject to an additional fee.
